NOTICE OF DEFEATING OF BY-LAWS (CHILD CARE)

At the Regular Meeting of Council held on Tuesday, July 13th, 2004 a Report regarding the proposed fee increases, elimination of flex days and the cancellation policy at the Golden and Red Lake Day Care Centres was received and reviewed by Council.

By-Law Nos. 434-04 and 435-04 were DEFEATED at Third Reading.

NOTICE TO ALL TAXPAYERS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF RED LAKE

If you own residential property in the Municipality of Red Lake, please note that the 2004 final bill(s) will be mailed by August 3rd, 2004. The due dates for residential property taxes are:

The first installment is due August 31st, 2004.
The second installment is due October 29th, 2004.

If you own property that is in the commercial, industrial or multi-residential property class or a combination of these classes, you will be receiving your bill at a later date. The property tax due dates for these properties are:

The first installment is due September 30th, 2004.
The second installment is due October 29th, 2004.

If you do not receive your tax bill, please contact the Municipal Office at 735-2096. Failure to receive a bill does not absolve a taxpayer from responsibility for payment of taxes or penalty/interest charges.

Payments must be received at the Municipal Office on or before the due date. A penalty charge of 1.25% is added for non-payment the day after the due date and the first day of each month thereafter until paid.

Payments may be made by mail or at any bank, or by way of telebanking or online banking. They may also be paid at the Municipal Office by way of cash, credit card, Interac, cheque or postdated cheque.

BUILDING PERMITS

The Municipality of Red Lake Building Department requires a Building Permit to be issued for all construction in the Municipality of Red Lake. This includes any new buildings, renovations, repairs, alterations or additions to existing buildings. Alterations and renovations include such things as recreation rooms, basement rooms, new doors, windows and patio decks. A Building Permit is also required when adding a woodstove, fireplace or a chimney to your building.

Municipal staff have the opportunity to make sure your building conforms to zoning requirements and that any new construction does not take place over easements or other property restrictions. You are reminded that all building plans, including site plans are required to be in metric measurements.
