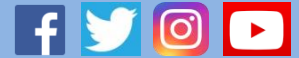

Reminder: 2021 Dog Licenses

2021 Dog Tags are available for purchase by calling the Municipal Office at 735-2096.

The cost of a dog license is as follows:

- Spayed/neutered - \$15.00
- Non-spayed/non-neutered - \$30.00
- Each dog in excess of two is \$100.00

After January 31st, 2021 – late penalty - \$10.00.

Tips from the By-Law Department – Feeding Wildlife

DO NOT feed any wildlife – either intentionally or unintentionally. Making food available can attract wildlife to your property, can make them less fearful of humans, and make them accustomed to food provided by humans.

Some suggestions to help keep wildlife away from your property:

- Properly store garbage in containers. Put garbage at curbside the morning of collection and not overnight.
- Ensure bird seed is in a bird feeder.
- Prune fruit trees.

The minimum set fine under By-Law No. 41-2015 for the *intentional feeding of wildlife or making available food attractants or other substances for the consumption of wildlife*, is a minimum of \$300.00 per offence.

Emergency Registration Form

The Corporation of The Municipality of Red Lake invites residents who require **special assistance** to participate in providing valuable information to the Municipality in the event of a Community Emergency.

Examples of those that are **most vulnerable in an emergency situation**:

- the elderly;
- disabled;
- special medical requirements;
- live alone and no local support network; and/or
- lack of transportation.

The Clerk's Office maintains a listing of the Emergency Registration Forms. If you completed an Emergency Registration Form in 2019 or 2020, you are not required to complete another one, unless your information requires an update.
