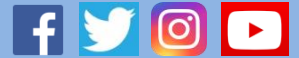

Update: Status of Municipal Facilities

The Province has announced a safe and gradual lifting of public health measures and effective Friday, June 11th the province is in *Step 1* of the Roadmap to Reopening. It is expected we will be able to enter *Step 2* on or around July 2nd. Please see below how this update will affect our Municipal Facilities:

Roads/Sidewalks Project

With financial assistance from the Provincial and Federal Governments the Municipality is completing a major road and sidewalk rehabilitation initiative in Red Lake. This includes new concrete sidewalks, curbing and asphalt. It also includes necessary underground storm sewer pipes replacement.

We appreciate our Public Works crew for working so diligently to prepare for and complete this road rehabilitation in a timely manner. This is a two-year project that was delayed in 2020 due to reasons beyond our control. This project is expected to be complete by the end of 2021.

While this construction may cause inconveniences, including delays in commuting, we are all very excited to see the end results of new asphalt roadways and increased access to sidewalks.

We assure you we are doing everything possible to ensure there is minimal impact to our residents. We thank you for your patience and understanding during this time and look forward to the end result!
