Emergency Alerts

We urge all residents to sign up for our Emergency Alert system. Alerts will be issued through this system in the event of an emergency. You can sign up to receive alerts via text, voice call (including landline phones) and/or email.

You can also sign up to receive the following non-emergency alerts:

- Boil Water Advisories
- Road and Facility Closures
- Ferry Service Disruptions.

NOTE: If you have already registered for Emergency Alerts, but want to include the additional non-emergency alerts, you will need to register again.

Emergency Kits

It is important to have emergency kits ready and available in the event you have to leave your home unexpectedly.

Some things to consider including when preparing an emergency kit:

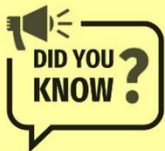
- Food (non-perishable) and a manual can opener
- Radio (crank or battery-run)
- Extra batteries
- Candles and matches/lighter
- Important papers
- Extra car keys and cash
- Phone charger

By-Law Department Tip of the Month – Feeding of Wildlife

Did you know that feeding of wildlife either intentionally or unintentionally is not permitted in the Municipality?

Making food available can attract wildlife to your property, can make them less fearful of humans, and make them accustomed to food provided by humans.

Some suggestions to help keep wildlife away from your property:

- Properly store garbage in containers. Put garbage at curbside the morning of collection and not overnight.
- Ensure bird seed is in a bird feeder.

The minimum set fine under By-Law No. 41-2015 for the *intentional feeding of wildlife or making available food attractants or other substances for the consumption of wildlife*, is \$300.00 per offence.
