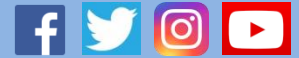

The following programs are available to eligible businesses and landowners (Commercial, Industrial, Affordable Housing):

- Design and Study Grant
- Planning Application and Building Permit Fee Grant
- Façade, Signage and Landscape Improvement Grant
- Brownfield Financial Tax Incentive Program
- Building and Accessibility Improvement Grant
- Parking Optimization Grant
- Commercial and Rental Housing Conversion and Expansion Grant
- Tax Increment Equivalent Grant (TIEG)
