Waste & Recycling Holiday Schedule

Waste & Recycling curbside collection originally scheduled for **Friday, December 24th** will now be picked up on **Thursday, December 23rd**. All other collection schedules remain unchanged.

Christmas Tree Curbside Collection Wednesday, January 12th, 2022

Trees must be cut in half and placed on the curbside the evening before or the day of collection. Trees must be easily accessible and not have been plowed into the snow bank. Trees must NOT be wrapped in a plastic bag. Trees will not be collected unless all the above conditions are met.

Trees can also be dropped off at the Municipal Transfer Station for **FREE** during normal operating hours.

Was your water bill a little high? Check your Water Usage

You can check your water usage and find out if you have any leaks. Visit our website at www.redlake.ca.

You will need to enter your water meter number (10 digit number listed on your invoice below 'WM') and your address EXACTLY as shown on your invoice (include all CAPS, lower case, spaces and abbreviations).

If your status shows a leak – check all your taps and toilets for running water and make the necessary repairs to avoid additional water usage charges.

Recycling Reminders

The following items **ARE NOT** recyclable:

PAPER PRODUCTS

Tissue paper, wrapping paper, bows, hard covers of books, paper towel/tissues, wax paper

BOXBOARD & CARDBOARD

Disposable coffee cups (Tim Horton's brands are permitted), frozen juice containers, containers with metal bottoms or trim (ie. Pringles, coffee containers, iced tea mix containers, etc.)

METAL

Aluminum foil, aluminum food containers (ie. pie plates, etc.), pots & pans, cookie sheets, metal hangers

PLASTIC

Plastic shopping bags, Ziploc bags, plastic lined bags (ie. dog food bags, chip bags, candy wrappers), plastic wrap, cutlery, toys, hoses, bubble wrap, planting flats and pots

GLASS

All glass, ceramic, mirrors

STYROFOAM

Foam packaging, cups, egg cartons, meat trays, foam containers, packing peanuts

The following items **ARE** recyclable:

PAPER PRODUCTS

Newspapers, flyers, magazines, books (with hard cover removed), telephone books, computer paper, brown paper bags, shredded paper (placed in a clear or blue translucent bag), envelopes (with windows removed)

BOXBOARD & CARDBOARD

Juice/milk cartons, tetra packs (juice boxes), cereal/cracker boxes (with inner plastic bag removed), tissue boxes, paper rolls/tubes, shoe boxes, cardboard egg cartons, disposable coffee cups (Tim Horton's brand **ONLY**), corrugated cardboard boxes, pizza boxes

METAL

Food & beverage cans and lids

PLASTIC

Plastic bottles, jugs, containers and lids with the following numbers: #2-7 in a recycling symbol, #1 in a recycling symbol on clear plastic (ie. single use food trays and containers)

GLASS

None

STYROFOAM

None

Feeding of Wildlife

REMINDER! Do not feed any wildlife – either intentionally or unintentionally. Making food available can attract wildlife to your property, can make them less fearful of humans, and make them accustomed to food provided by humans.

Some suggestions to help keep wildlife away from your property:

- Properly store garbage in containers. Put garbage at curbside the morning of collection and not overnight.
- Ensure bird seed is in a bird feeder.

The minimum set fine under By-Law No. 41-2015 for the *intentional feeding of wildlife or making available food attractants or other substances for the consumption of wildlife*, is a minimum of \$300.00 per offence.



