FUNDING ANNOUNCED FOR AREA WATER TREATMENT PLANTS

On Wednesday, September 1st, Bill Mauro, Parliamentary Assistant to Rick Bartolucci, Northern Development and Mines Minister, visited Red Lake to announce a NOHFC grant of \$2,655,216 to be used for the upgrading of the Municipality of Red Lake's Water Treatment Plants. When completed, the WTP's will supply the Municipality's residents with safe clean drinking water.

The Municipality would like to advise the residents of Madsen that testing of the Madsen Water Treatment Plant (WTP) will start during the week of September 13th, 2004. If no problems are encountered, the testing program will be completed within seventeen days. After the testing process is completed, the disinfecting process will commence and this will take four days. The Madsen WTP is expected to be operational near the middle of October.

Golden Ward residents are advised that the construction on the Golden WTP will take approximately six to seven more weeks, with the testing and disinfecting to follow. If all goes well, the WTP will be operational in late November or early December.

The Municipality of Red Lake apologizes for these delays, but they are beyond our control.
