## **NEW CANADA POST BOXES IN COCHENOUR**

The owners of the present Canada Post Outlet in Cochenour have given notice that they will not be renewing the lease with Canada Post. As no other space has been made available, Canada Post has made the decision to install outside postal boxes for service in Cochenour.

The Municipality of Red Lake, in an effort to maintain the best possible Postal service to the residents of Cochenour, has provided property on the corner of William Street and Lakeview Avenue for Canada Post to install these postal boxes. Mail delivery to these boxes will become effective October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2004.

## **PILOT PROJECT BEING TESTED AT LANDFILL SITE**

In an effort to reduce volumes of waste and minimize burning, the Municipality of Red Lake is undertaking a pilot project to chip trees, shrubs and clippings at the landfill site.

The clippings will be stockpiled at the landfill site beginning September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2004, and chipping will be initiated as volumes dictate. Residents are encouraged to bring their clippings to the landfill site. The chipper is available until October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2004. Trees, shrubs and clippings are limited to 4 inches in diameter and under.

If volumes of chips are sufficient, the mulch will be made available for use by organizations and individuals.

## **MADSEN CURLING RINK**

The Madsen Curling Rink has sustained major damage due to water leaks and acts of vandalism during the past year. Due to the repairs estimated in excess of \$5,500.00 and escalating operating costs, a resolution to permanently close the rink is being brought forward for Council's consideration at the next Regular Meeting of Council to be held October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2004.
