NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**CONCERNING A NEW OFFICIAL PLAN AND ZONING BY-LAW**

The Planning Advisory Committee of the Municipality of Red Lake will hold a Public Meeting on Thursday, December 9th, 2004, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Office, Fifth Street and Lassie Road, in Balmertown to consider a new Official Plan and Zoning By-Law under Sections 17 and 34 of the Planning Act.

The new Official Plan and Zoning By-Law will replace existing documents. The documents will cover all lands within the Municipality of Red Lake. The purpose of the Official Plan is to establish clear and practical objectives and policies to guide future physical changes for a projected ten-year period. The purpose of the Zoning By-Law is to regulate the use of land.

Copies of the document are available for review during regular office hours. Anyone wishing to address the Planning Advisory Committee with respect to the documents may do so at the Public Meeting. Persons unable to attend the Public Meeting may provide written comments to the Planning Advisory Committee up until the Public Meeting.

Anyone wishing to be notified of the adoption of the proposed documents must make a written request to the address shown below.

A key map illustrating the lands affected by the proposed Official Plan and Zoning By-Law is not included in this Notice since the proposed Official Plan and Zoning By-Law affect all lands within the boundary of the Municipality of Red Lake.

If a person or public body that files a notice of appeal of a decision of the Municipality of Red Lake in respect of the proposed documents does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Municipality of Red Lake before the proposed documents are adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.

911 UPDATE

Bell Canada has reviewed the submission for 911 Service for the Municipality of Red Lake. Bell Canada has instructed that certain procedures be completed prior to implementation of the 911 Service.

The first procedure is to inform all residents of their proper street address. All homeowners, tenants, etc. will be receiving a letter from the Municipality of Red Lake in the next few weeks to advise of their proper street address. In most cases, the current street address will change. All homes will require the proper numerical numbers on their homes, and in order to expedite this process, Council has approved to provide all numbers.

Information regarding the pick up or delivery of the numbers will be noted in the letter. If you have not received a letter by November 30th, 2004, please contact the Municipal Office @ 735-2096.
