The Municipality of Red Lake would like to remind all residents that are on the Balmertown, Cochenour and McKenzie Island, Municipal Water Distribution System that the **Boil Advisory is still in effect.**

The Cochenour Water Treatment Plant and Balmertown Pumping Station are servicing the three communities, but until the safety of the water supply can be assured, **all water used for human consumption should be boiled for at least one (1) minute.**
