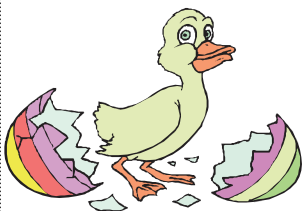
Easter Garbage Collection Schedule
