FIRE PERMITS

The Fire Season has arrived. As of April 1st any burning in the Municipality requires a fire permit. The Fire Season continues until October 31st.

The Permittee shall ensure the following:

- Fire is supervised at all times by someone who is at least 18 years of age;
- No fire is left unattended; and
- The Permittee assumes full responsibilities.

*** There is to be absolutely no daytime burning during the fire season ***

Any person who starts a fire outdoors or is in charge of one, shall ensure the following:

- All conditions will allow the fire to burn safely;
- Steps to keep fire in control will be taken;
- Fire will be extinguished before leaving the site;
- There are sufficient resources available to maintain & control the fire;
- No fire shall be lit until 2 hours before sunset; and
- All fires must be fully out by 2 hours after sunrise.

FINAL NOTICE – NEW CIVIC ADDRESSES

In order to obtain Emergency 911 Service for the area, the Municipality of Red Lake has reorganized its street numbering system.

Notices were forwarded at the end of November 2004, to all Property Owners that were receiving a new civic address. There was an allowance of sixty (60) days to affix or erect the new civic address in an area that is easily found.

The new civic address shall be affixed or erected by April 18th, 2005. After this date, the Municipality will be installing the new civic address at the property owner's expense.
