ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN-UP

The Municipality of Red Lake will be holding it's Annual Spring Clean-Up on Monday, May 9th to Friday, May 20th, 2005.

Glass bottle collection will be held at the Red Lake and Balmertown Public Works Shops on Monday, May 9th to Saturday, May 14th, 2005 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. The 10¢ return will again apply. Bring the bottle return receipt issued to you at the Public Works Shop to the Municipal Office during regular office hours, Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for payment.

A reminder to residents that pick-up is limited to a volume equal to 4ft. x 6ft. x 8ft. (approximately 7 cu. yards). Materials should be separated into metals, wood (organics) and mixed waste. Tires, batteries, oil and hazardous goods will not be picked up. Refrigerators and freezers must be drained with certificate attached.

Homeowners should try and limit the material to general accumulated waste items that they find difficult to transport. The Spring Clean-Up is not meant to clear tree removals, building demolition, renovation waste, etc. It is intended as a way that homeowners can clean up their yards of debris that tends to accumulate over the winter.

Material must be piled adjacent to the road fronting the resident's property, but must not protrude onto the road. Material should be bagged, boxed, or bundled where practical. Do not leave any containers that you want returned, as all material taken will be disposed of.

The Landfill Site will be open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily Monday through Saturday during this time for free disposal (except tires, batteries, oil, and hazardous goods) if residents choose to dispose of their own goods.

MAINTENANCE AND OCCUPANCY BY-LAW

The Property Standards By-Law states that all yards must be kept clean and free from the following:

- Rubbish or debris and objects or conditions that may create a health, fire or accident hazard;
- Inoperative motor vehicles, wrecked, dismantled, discarded or abandoned machinery, vehicles, trailers or boats, unless it is necessary for the operation of a business enterprise lawfully situated on the property;
- Long grass, brush, undergrowth and noxious weeds as defined by the Weed Control Act;
- Dilapidated, collapsed or partially constructed structures which are not currently under construction;
- Injurious insects, termites, rodents, vermin or other pests; and
- Dead, decayed or damaged trees or other natural growth.

Property Inspections are going to be completed this spring. If a property is not in compliance with the By-Law, the violations will have to be remedied. If the violations are not remedied, then the Municipality has the authority to correct the violations at the cost of the property owner(s).
