By-Law 597-05 re Establish Procedures regarding Connection to the Municipality of Red Lake Water Systems and Establish Water Use Restrictions to Municipal Water Systems.

SERVICE SYSTEMS CONNECTIONS SUMMARY RE BY-LAW 597-05

Water Turn On/Off – Residents must fill out an application form before water will be turned on or off at the curbside. These forms may be obtained at the Municipal Office during regular business hours, 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

Water System Valves and Hydrants may only be operated by authorized personnel, whether or not on private property.

The Municipality may impose water conservation measures if it is deemed necessary.
