## **NOTICE OF PASSING OF BY-LAW 610-05**

**RE: BY-LAW NUMBER 610-05 TO ADOPT THE ESTIMATES OF MUNICIPAL SUMS REQUIRED DURING THE YEAR AND TO STRIKE THE RATES OF TAXATION FOR THE YEAR 2005.**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake has passed By-Law Number 610-05 at the Regular Meeting of Council held Tuesday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2005, to adopt the estimates of municipal sums required and strike the rates of taxation.
