HAMMELL ROAD DIVERSION APPROVED BY COUNCIL

At the Regular Meeting of Council, held on July 19th, 2005, Council reviewed Public comments regarding the Howey Mine Closure Plan presented at information sessions held at the Red Lake Recreation Centre and hosted by Teck Cominco Ltd. in cooperation with the Municipality of Red Lake. Options A, B and C for the diversion of Hammell Road were presented. Resolution Number 425-05, approving Option "A", which involves the full diversion of Hammell Road to the south side of existing businesses, was approved.

This resolution will be forwarded to Teck Cominco for their consideration in preparing the Closure Plan for the Howey Mine Site.

ACCESSIBILITY PLAN

The Municipality is reviewing their Accessibility Plan. The Plan describes the measures the Municipality has taken in the past and the measures the Municipality will take during the current year to identify, remove and prevent barriers to people with disabilities who use the facilities and services of the Municipality, including staff and members of the community at large. The Plan will be completed by August 17th, 2005. PROPERTY STANDARDS

The Property Standards By-Law states that all yards must be kept clean and free from the following:

- Rubbish or debris and objects or conditions that may create a health, fire or accident hazard;
- Inoperative motor vehicles, wrecked, dismantled, discarded or abandoned machinery, vehicles, trailers or boats unless it is necessary for the operation of a business enterprise lawfully situated on the property;
- Long grass, brush, undergrowth and noxious weeds as defined by the Weed Control Act;
- Dilapidated, collapsed or partially constructed structures which are not currently under construction;
- Injurious insects, termites, rodents, vermin or other pest; and
- Dead, decayed or damaged trees or other natural growth.

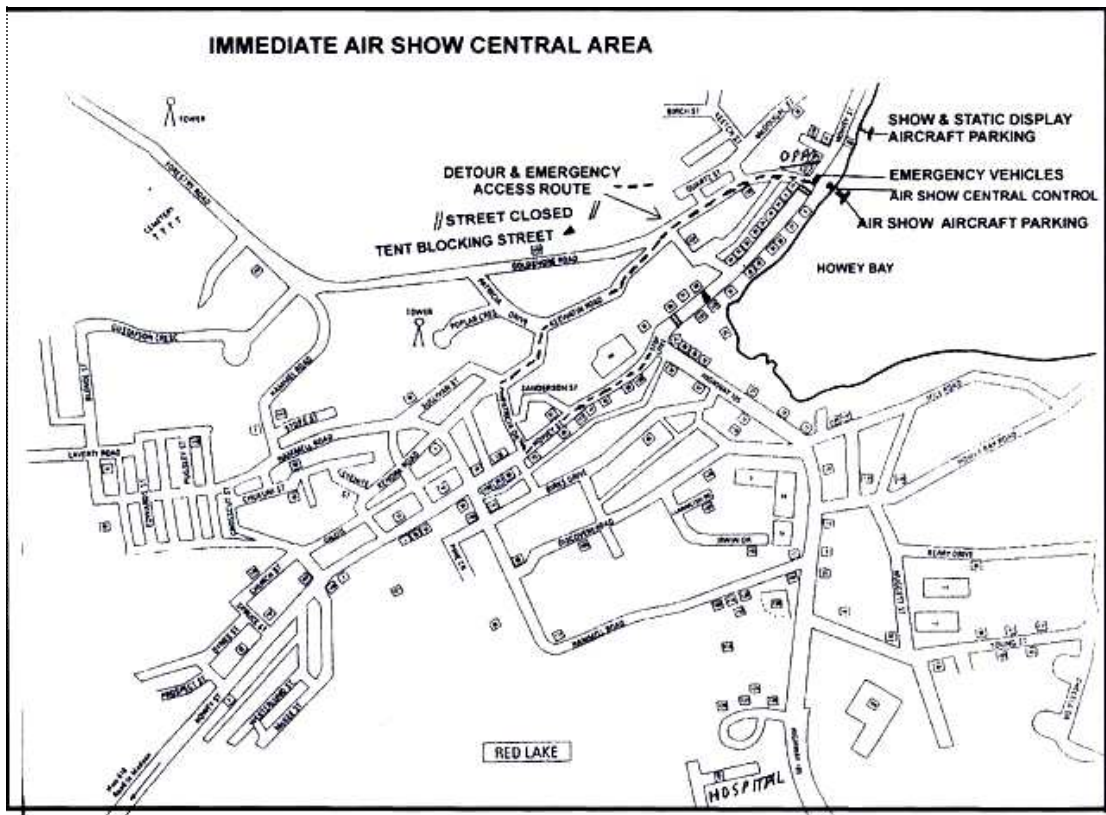
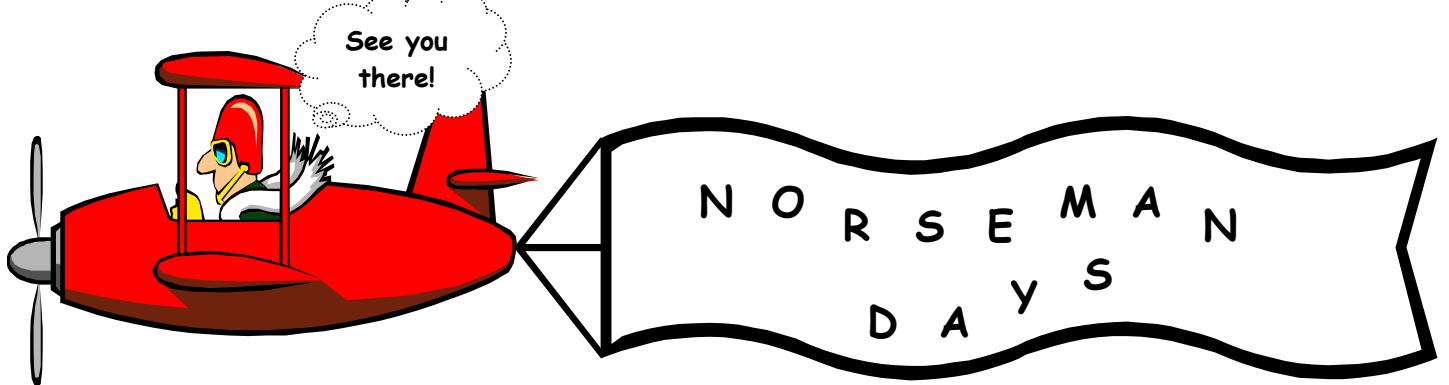
