NOTICE TO ALL TAXPAYERS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF RED LAKE

If you own property in the Municipality of Red Lake, please note that the 2005 Final bill(s) were mailed on August 10th, 2005. The final due date for all taxes in all classes is October 31st, 2005.

If you did not receive your tax bill, please contact the Municipal Office at 735-2096 ext. 30. Failure to receive a bill does not absolve a taxpayer from responsibility for payment of taxes or penalty/interest charges.

Payments must be received at the Municipal Office on or before the due date. A penalty charge of 1.25% is added for non-payment the day after the due date, and the first day of each month thereafter until paid.

Payments may be made by mail, at the CIBC, Lakewood Credit Union or the Bank of Nova Scotia, or by way of Telebanking or Internet banking. They may also be paid at the Municipal Office by way of cash, credit card, Interac, or cheque.

2005 COMMUNITIES IN BLOOM AWARDS

The local Communities in Bloom Committee can again take pride in having been presented the Hydro One, Top Honours for Gateways Award, for Communities with less than 5,000 people within the Province of Ontario. This award recognizes the work that has been done at the Welcome Sign at the junction of Highways 105 and 125.

In the Bloom Ratings Awards, which are based on floral displays, landscapes, turf, urban forestry, community involvement, heritage conservation, environmental awareness and tidiness, they were awarded the 4-bloom rating. This is the second year the Committee has received these two awards.
