INTENT TO ADOPT BY-LAW

It is the intent of the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Red Lake to give three readings to a by-law on Tuesday, December 20th, 2005, to formally amend Schedule "A" – Prohibited Waste Materials and Schedule "B" – Waste Disposal Site Entry Ticket Fees of By-Law Number 530-04. The new rates will take effect and come into force on January 1st, 2006.

Fees & Charges re Users of Waste Management System

Subject

Amend fees re Waste Management System.

Background

The Municipal Act, 2001, O. Reg. 244/02 (Fees & Charges), s.12 (2) states that "the amount of fees or charges for the use of a waste management system, for the use of a sewage system or the consumption of water shall not exceed the cost of providing the waste management system, the sewage system or the water system, as the case may be.

The Municipal Act, 2001, O. Reg. 244/02 (Fees & Charges), s.12 (6) states that before passing a by-law imposing a fee or charge, the municipality or local board, as the case may be shall:

- (a) hold at least one public meeting at which any person who attends has an opportunity to make representation with respect to the matter; and
- (b) ensure that a minimum of 21 days notice of the public meeting is given.

Financial Implication

The 2005 Budget shows a budgeted operating cost for the landfill site at \$110,000.00.

Wages/Payroll	\$ 39,000.00
Repairs/Maintenance/Operating	\$ 25,000.00
Post Closure/Reserve/Etc.	\$ 30,000.00

*This does not include the collection contract or capital expenses.

The 2005 Budget shows a revenue amount of \$35,000.00. The current revenue, to date, is \$33,954.08.

It is anticipated that there will be no additional solid waste revenue based on the information available at this time. A review of the revenue will be completed in the new year to more accurately assess revenue from waste disposal fee versus actual expenditures.

Rationale for why the Fee is being Imposed

The Municipality of Red Lake is in the process of installing weigh scales at the Municipality of Red Lake Waste Disposal Site. To accommodate the change, a schedule to include a rate for weigh scales must be completed. The rates take into consideration the actual cost of operating the landfill site, site improvement costs, site closure costs, post-closure costs, reserve funds and other costs as may be required.
