4.14 PAYMENT FOR MUNICIPAL SERVICES PROVIDED TO NON RESIDENT
BUSINESSES

1. BACKGROUND

In view of the number of cheques returned for non sufficient funds, coupled with the lengthy delays, difficulties and costs incurred procuring payment for services provided to non-resident businesses, it has become necessary to implement stricter terms for payment of services provided and the elimination of charge accounts.

2. NON-RESIDENT BUSINESSES

A non-resident business shall be deemed as any business that does not have a permanent physical business location established; either rental or owned, within the boundaries of the Municipality of Red Lake.

3. RESIDENT BUSINESSES

A resident business shall be deemed as any business that does have a permanent physical business location established; either rental or owned, within the boundaries of the Municipality of Red Lake.

4. PAYMENT FOR SERVICES

Services rendered shall be paid for prior to provision of the service. Payment shall be in the form of cash, credit card or certified cheque. At facilities that do not have a credit card terminal (i.e. Land Fill) the acceptable forms of payment shall be in cash or by certified cheque.

5. CREDIT PRIVILEGES – NON-RESIDENT BUSINESSES

Effective with the passing of this policy, new credit privileges shall no longer be extended to non-resident businesses.

Non-resident businesses with existing credit privileges shall retain those privileges. In the event an existing account becomes delinquent, credit privileges shall be terminated and be subject to the terms of Clause 4.

Non-resident businesses with existing credit privileges and currently delinquent or a history of delinquent accounts shall have existing credit privileges terminated and be subject to the terms of Clause 4.

6. CREDIT PRIVILEGES - RESIDENT BUSINESSES

Resident businesses with any delinquent accounts (services, utilities or taxes) shall have credit privileges terminated and be subject to the terms of Clause 4.
