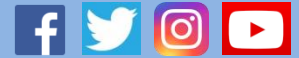

New! Building Permit Applications

We have retained the services of RSM Building Consultants Inc. to administer Building Permits and enforce the Building Code for the Municipality of Red Lake. These services will be provided to residents and builders remotely and will offer the convenience of allowing Building Permit Applications to be completed online through the online software service - Cloudpermit.

Cloudpermit allows you to apply for and check the status of your building permit application anywhere, at any time. You can start an application and finish it later, receive email updates on the status of your permit application and even request building inspections. Be Bear Wise!

While it may not seem like it yet, soon enough the Bears will be coming out of hibernation. We would like to remind residents that the Feeding of Wildlife By-Law states that no person shall feed or make available food attractants or other substances for the consumption of wildlife. In order to minimize wildlife encounters residents must ensure all attractants such as food products/scraps, garbage, pet food and bird seed is properly stored and all waste is to be placed at the curb in the morning of pickup (not the night before).

The Municipality is responsible for enforcing all Municipal By-Laws. The MNR and the Red Lake OPP work collectively with our By-Law Enforcement Officer to ensure the safety of our residents as it relates to wildlife encounters, including bear encounters.

Learn what to do in the event of a bear encounter:

For emergency situations - if the bear poses immediate threat to public safety by exhibiting threatening or aggressive behaviour, call 911.

For non-emergency encounters or information and advice on reducing bear attractants call the Bear Wise reporting line at 1-866-514-2327. You will be connected to an operator during bear season (April 1st to November 30th). Visit www.ontario.ca/bearwise for more information.

Update – Arena/Events Centre

This project (now termed R.E.A.C.H - Regional Events, Arts & Cultural Hub), is still very much a distinct goal for the Municipality. The Municipality continues to seek out funding opportunities and actively engages with both the Provincial and Federal Governments to assist with construction costs of this new facility.

REACH is now shovel-ready with Class “A” Engineered Drawings complete and the site on Hughes Crescent has been cleared for construction. This facility will boast not only a new arena, but an indoor walking track, multi-purpose rooms to host various events and activities as well as an attached performing arts centre.

A volunteer fundraising group has been established and has been working on various initiatives over the years in an effort to cover a portion of the costs of the project. To date, this group has raised almost \$10,000.00!

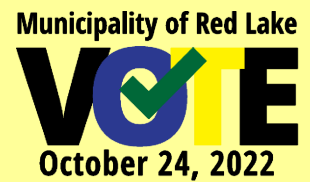

2022 Municipal and School Board Elections Notice of Nomination for Office

Municipal Elections Act, 1996



Notice is hereby given to the Electors of the Municipality of Red Lake that Nomination Forms may be filed commencing Monday, May 2, 2022 for the following offices:

Municipal Council:

- Mayor – One (1) to be elected
- Councillors – Four (4) to be elected

School Board Trustees: One (1) to be elected per School Board

- English Public – Keewatin-Patricia District School Board
- English Separate – Kenora Catholic District School Board
- French-Language Public – Conseil scolaire de district du Grand Nord de l'Ontario
- French-Language Separate – Conseil scolaire de district catholique des Aurores Boreales

The term of office is November 15, 2022 to November 14, 2026.

Nomination Forms may be filed in person or by an agent at the Municipal Office in Balmertown, ON, accompanied by a declaration of qualification and with the prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200.00 for the office of Mayor and \$100.00 for all other offices. The filing fee shall be paid by cash, debit card, certified cheque or money order payable to the Municipality of Red Lake (credit cards not accepted).

Nomination Forms may be filed during regular business hours, Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. commencing Monday, May 2, 2022 through to Thursday, August 18, 2022 AND on Nomination Day, Friday, August 19, 2022 between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., after which time nominations for all offices shall close.

A Nomination Form must be certified by the Municipal Clerk before such person becomes a Candidate for office. A Nomination Form must be filed prior to campaigning; accepting campaign contributions or incurring campaign expenses.

A person is entitled to run for office if they are not disqualified by any Act and if, on Voting Day, Monday, October 24, 2022, they are a Canadian citizen, at least 18 years old, reside in the Municipality of Red Lake; or is the owner or tenant of land in the Municipality of Red Lake, or the spouse of such a person.

The election will be conducted by the internet and telephone voting method. Voter assistance will be provided during the Voting Period of October 15 – October 24, 2022.

Nomination Forms and Candidate Information Packages will be available at the Municipal Office commencing May 2, 2022.
