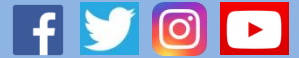

We will be offering 100 FoodCycler units at a subsidized price of \$175, plus HST to registered residents of the Municipality of Red Lake. Registrations will be received on a first-come, first-served bases. Only the first 100 successfully registered participants will be contacted with purchase and pick up information.
